State Governance and Rulemaking 101

Description

This session provides an introduction and overview of the North Dakota State Board of Dental Examiners (Board)—the state governmental entity charged with the responsibility of regulating the practice of dentistry. Included will be a discussion of Board members, appointments and terms of office, laws that govern the dental profession, and the Board's roles, duties, obligations, and limitations. Specific attention will be paid to the complaints and disciplinary process, and the Board's rulemaking responsibilities.

- 6. The Rulemaking process, including the overall procedure and the roles of the Board, its licensees, stakeholders, and the Legislative Assembly.
- 7. Your opportunities and means of effectively engaging with the Board.
